 - We are 200 calls ahead of last year at this time. VA calls are up significantly.
- Building Update
 - Project update was given.
 - Working on small issues to be fixed.
 - Keller still does a weekly check in.
- o Vehicle Update
 - Unit 269 should be back at the end of May or beginning of June.
 - Normal wear and tear on the units (tires, brakes, and oil changes).
 - The next oldest ambulance has 196,000 miles on and will be next to be remounted.

- o The proposed increase would be \$150.00 an hour for events outside of our service area.
- These special events and not a money maker for the service but we do need to take into consideration paying for the staff at these events.
