- Staffing
  - We hired two of the three full-time staff members in March, both are senior medics.
  - Possible internal candidates for the third full-time position.
  - We have hired two part-time staff members and are looking to hire one more part-time staff member.
  - With the addition of new staff members, we can staff four trucks and take more out of the service area transfers.
- o Building Update
  - Project update was given.
  - Overhead door issues, waiting on parts to fix.
- Vehicle Update
  - Unit 267 is in the painting process.
  - We are looking at late May for Unit 267 to be completed.
  - Normal basic wear and tear, and regular maintenance.
  - Goal for next remount is the end of 2025.



- o Monthly statistics and invoices presented for March 2025.
  - See Attached Director's Report.
  - Higher invoices in March due to service contracts.
  - FAP funding was increased from 2 million dollars to 25 million dollars statewide. Which increased our funding from approximately \$6,500.00 to \$68,000.00 for fiscal year 2024.
  - GEMT Medicaid supplemental reimbursement program starting with year 2023. There is the possibility of up to a 50% increase per call. This program will continue year to year.
