

City of Tomah Planning Commission Minutes

The City of Tomah Planning Commission met in regular session on Thursday, September 26, 2019 at 5:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 819 Superior Avenue, Tomah, WI. Planning Commission Vice-Chair, Bryan Meyer, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

- 1) Roll call was taken with Commissioners: Mary Ann Komiskey, Tina Thompson, Bryan Meyer, Brian Rice and Jeff Cram present. Quorum Present. Absent: Remy Gomez and Mike Murray. Also, present: Ex-Officio, City Building Inspector, Shane Rolff.
- 2) Motion by Thompson, seconded by Cram, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.
- 3) A public hearing was open at 5:30 P.M. to consider amendments to the City of Tomah Floodplain Zoning Ordinance, Repealing and Replacing Chapter 22. There was no public present to speak in favor or against the ordinance change. City Building Inspector, Shane Rolff stated that the DNR has a model ordinance that the City, along with Monroe County, has to adapt to stay compliant with FEMA regulations. These changes are minor. The public hearing was closed at 5:35 P.M.
- 4) Motion by Thompson, seconded by Komiskey, to approve the repeal and replacement of the current floodplain zoning ordinance, to stay compliant with FEMA regulations, once properly formatted. All ayes. Motion carried.
- 5) Motion by Cram, seconded by Thompson, to adjourn. All ayes. Motion carried. Meeting adjourn 5:36 PM.
