- (2) If a customer does not fulfill the terms of this Deferred Payment Agreement and there has not been a documented significant change in the customer's ability to pay since the Agreement was negotiated, the utility shall have the right to disconnect the utility service and shall not be required to offer a subsequent Deferred Payment Agreement prior to disconnection.
- (3) Any payments received under this Agreement will be applied first to the agreed upon installment payments, with the remaining amount being applied to current charges.
- (4) In the event service is disconnected, it shall not be reconnected without payment of all past due charges and payment of the reconnection charge (\$30.00).
- (5) The failure of the City of Tomah Water Utility, at any time, to insist upon strict performance or observance of any term, agreement or condition contained in this Agreement shall not be construed as a release of any right of the City hereunder or applicable laws or as a waiver of any right to enforcement, including but not limited to the discontinuance of service.
- (6) Pursuant to section (4) of the PSC 185.38, Adm. Code, you are hereby notified as follows:
 - (a) You have the right to suggest a different payment arrangement;
 - (b) If you believe the terms of this Agreement are unreasonable, DO NOT SIGN IT.
 - (c) If you and the City of Tomah Water Utility cannot agree on terms, you may ask the Public Service Commission to review the disputed issues;
 - (d) If you sign this agreement, you agree that you owe the amount due under the Agreement; and
 - (e) Signing this Agreement does not affect your responsibility to pay for your current service. <u>Allowing any bill for current service to</u> become delinquent places you in default of this Agreement.
